


**Rules of using Laboratory of Internal Combustion Engines designated for research
and classes,**

**binding from 1 October 2020, implemented in relation to Regulation No. 104/2020
of the WUT Rector of 30 September 2020**

1. The Laboratory of Internal Combustion Engines may be entered only by a healthy person, without symptoms suggesting an infectious disease. It may not be entered by students, teachers or other employees, who are ill or stay in the house with a person undergoing quarantine or home isolation, or are in quarantine or home isolation themselves.
2. One may not bring unnecessary objects into the room.
3. It is advised to use mobile phone only in a situation of threat.
4. The laboratory room is opened according to the schedule of research works or classes by the Laboratory Supervisor, or the person designated by the Supervisor.
5. Internal Combustion Engines Laboratory classes can be held in the following rooms: 1.1 A, 1.1B, 1.1F, 1.1G and 0.2 (engine dynamometer test cell).
6. Maximum number of people who can stay in the laboratory of Combustion Engines is **16**. Only **4** people may stay in one of the four test cells. Exception is the Control Room, where maximum **3** people are allowed, whose presence is essential for its operation during the tests.
7. Maximum number of people who can stay in the Control Room during classes is **8** accompanied by the Laboratory Supervisor, but it is necessary to keep masks wearing all the time during the laboratory classes.
8. Everyone entering the laboratory is obliged to disinfect their hands with a disinfectant available by the entrance to the laboratory.
9. Everyone entering the laboratory premises should wear a face mask and, during operations on the equipment, disposable gloves. Protective products are available by the entrance to the laboratory.
10. If possible, every person uses their own supplies/things necessary for an efficient and effective realization of the works. All the objects commonly used must be disinfected, unless they are disposable. It is not allowed to lend objects to other people in the laboratory.
11. In the laboratory of Internal Combustion Engines, one may only take the work stations designated by the Laboratory Supervisor.
12. It is forbidden to move, relocate or change in any way the position of the furniture in the room, especially chairs and armchairs.

13. One may be present in the room for up to 120 min.
14. The break between one group leaves and another enters the room must be at least 30 min.
15. During the break the room shall be disinfected and ventilated. Laboratory Supervisor, or the person designated by them, is responsible for disinfecting the commonly used objects, in accordance with the specifics of the laboratory equipment.
16. When leaving the laboratory as well as in corridors, toilets and all other common areas, it is obligatory to cover the mouth and nose with a face mask.
17. In case of deterioration of health condition of people staying in the Internal Combustion Engines laboratory, the Head of the Laboratory **dr inż. Marcin K. Wojs**, tel: 725 990 841, email: marcin.wojs@pw.edu.pl must be informed immediately about this situation.
18. In case of a suspected infection of a person staying in the building of WUT Faculty of Automotive and Construction Machinery Engineering, until sanitary-epidemiological services take appropriate actions, room 3.5 is designated as an isolation room, in which one must abide by the rules of using room 3.5.
19. A person who is leaving the laboratory may throw the mask and gloves away into a container located by the entrance to the room.
